DXPEDITION REQUIREMENTS

(Part of the requirements for INDEXA's support)

- 1. DX entity to be activated must be in the Top 60 of Club Log's Most-Wanted List.
- Individual team members must make a substantial personal contribution to the project.
- INDEXA believes that funds contributed to a DXpedition should be used only for that purpose.
- DXpedition must upload their logs to Logbook of the World (LoTW) within six months after the DXpedition concludes.
- DXpedition team members must be required to review and understand information found in the booklet "DXpeditioning Basics" written by Wayne Mills, N7NG. (on website)
- Good operating practices and operating ethics are required for INDEXA support.

INDEXA remains committed to promoting the highest ethical operating standards within the worldwide DX community.

INDEXA supports only those DXpeditions that meet strict criteria and commit to meeting the objectives set out in their applications.


